

Packing Checklist

Recommended: One (1) piece of luggage & one (1) carry one (plus your garment bag and instrument). Please label these items with your name and phone number.

Check the weather for your destination and plan accordingly. Many activities take place outside regardless of weather conditions. Dress in layers to adjust to daily temperature changes.

If traveling by motorcoach: On the day of departure, once your luggage is stowed under the motorcoach, you will not have access until hotel check-in. Prior to departure, pack what you will need for your first day in your carry-on bag. On the final day of your trip, once the luggage is stowed under the motorcoach, you will not have access until you arrive home. Pack what you will need for the trip home in your carry-on.
